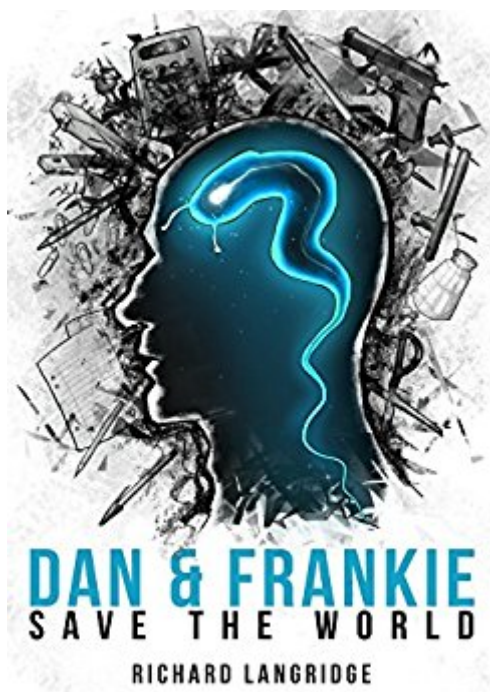

Disclaimer: I read this novel in draft form prior to final edits and publication. I loved it as a draft - enough to buy a copy upon publication. "Dan and Frankie" exudes zany screw-ball humor. (an example of how humorous: I am terrified of the dentist. While in the waiting room of my dentist, I

started reading this novel - and I FORGOT to be terrified. It is THAT good). The plot is reminiscent of alien body-snatcher movies I loved as a kid, but it does not, at any point, take itself seriously. Dan and his sidekick Frankie tumble through life, going from bad to worse to really, really icky - then they save the world (it isn't a spoiler if it's in the title). Buy this book. Read it. You will laugh.

Based on the title, it's not much of a spoiler to say that Dan and Frankie do save the world. How they go about it is the fun part of this book. It's definitely a fun read to see how they get into the position of having to be the unlikely saviors of the world.

If you're looking for something funny and that isn't too serious, I urge you to check out Dan and Frankie Save the World. I haven't laughed this much while reading a book in a long time. The two main characters, Dan and Frankie, are hilarious and likable even though they both mess up a lot and are far from perfect. I found myself rooting for them both while still laughing at the mistakes they made and the hijinks they got into. The topic of an alien invasion isn't something I would normally be interested in but the way the story was written held my interest all the way through. The humor and the two quirky main characters made me totally invested in what was happening. This is a promising debut novel and I hope this author writes more. I would love to see what happens next to Dan and Frankie.

First, let me say that I really enjoyed this book. The title characters are total idiots, but they manage to be likeable. However, the British-ness of the writing is both outputting and confusing. I was truly unsure of the book's setting for the first few chapters. If the author is going to set a book in the U.S., he should really take the time to learn about it.

This book was entertaining and hilarious. Good plot, well organized and it was easy to identify with the characters. Tremendously funny observations on life that a real person would make, not a created hero. Well worth reading particularly if you want to escape your worries and be entertained.

This is a hard book to categorize or explain. The "hero's" hilarious self talk goes off on weird and unexpected tangents that had me laughing all the way to the end. It was a lot of fun.
