I found myself studying the faces of the brave people who traveled from Europe to England to South America searching for a place where they could raise their children and worship God in safety. It made the book more real to me and it was helpful in putting faces to the names of people in the book. I also really enjoyed the descriptiveness of the book. I could easily imagine the difficulties in trying to keep young children clean amidst the boat ride only to arrive at their destination and be covered with swarming flies. Small details like that throughout the book gave me a great deal of respect for the families. I would have liked to have read more detail about one or two families as opposed to an overview of the entire group. I understand that the book is the story of the Bruderhof as a whole, but I would have liked to gotten to know a couple of families more deeply, instead of a general sense of the community. It would have made the book to read to learn about the community.
