Until Queen Victoriaâ [™]s rule of Britain, the Vikings were still portrayed as a violent and barbaric people. During the 19th and 20th centuries, perceptions changed to the point where Vikings were glamorized as noble savages with horned helmets, a proud culture and a feared prowess in battle. What should be a book worth wallowing in is a badly formatted editing nightmare that damages the information given. While there is some good information, typos and sentences that go nowhere with information cut off before getting to the finished stage hampers the reader and the message of the book, which is putting the Vikings center stage and in clear, undimmed light. From the run-on sentences to the repetitious words and information, this book buries more than the lead, it buries the reader in confusion with no regard for form or function. Auerbach would benefit from employing a beta reader and hiring content and line editors. Failing that, reading through his writing would point up the flaws and failings. The only surprising thing about the book is how badly it is put together, giving all independent writers a bad name. My message to Patrick Auerbach? Take some time with your book and read it over before rushing it into self-publishing.

Very, very poorly written. Filled with grammatical and spelling errors. Writing quality is akin to that of a middle school child. I often wondered if it was a poorly translated version from another language. There is no evidence of any scholarly research in the book. I do not understand how this book received so many positive reviews. Don't waste your time.

I wouldn't recommend this book as serious history for adults. It is perhaps suitable as an introduction for elementary school students. In fact, it reads like it was written by an 8th grader as a social studies report. Poorly researched, poorly written and rife with erroneous "facts". The author obviously didn't understand the subject material.
