

Though Longstreet tried to talk Lee out of the attacks, they went forward, and Longstreet criticized Lee about them afterward, making him reviled among other Confederates. In turn, they tried to blame him for the loss at Gettysburg. Â Although Longstreet would dive headfirst into the controversies in his memoirs, his account of the Battle of Fredericksburg is less controversial in both his memoirs and other writings about the battle. This account, part of the well known Battles & Leaders of the Civil War Series, discusses the strategy and tactics of the battle of Fredericksburg, and what Longstreet would have done differently than Burnside.Â
